Pandemic Electronic Benefits Transfer, also known as P-EBT, provides a stimulus to households with children eligible for **free or reduced-price school meals through National School Lunch Program (NSLP)** during the COVID-19 Response.

**During the COVID-19 State of Emergency,** Kentucky is providing benefits to households with students who attend public schools or private schools and qualify for free or reduced-price meals if the student's school district has a virtual or hybrid learning model.

P-EBT stimulus payments will begin the week of March 15, 2021. The stimulus payments are issued for past months covering October 2020-present and will continue through the rest of the school term (May 2021)


