


It's Mowing Season!

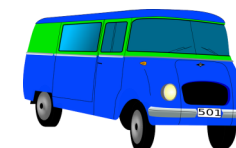

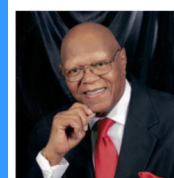


Individuals will be picked up within four hours.

Kentucky Pandemic Electronic Benefit Transfer (P-EBT)

Get help buying groceries during the COVID-19 Emergency

Introduction

Pandemic Electronic Benefits Transfer, also known as P-EBT, provides a stimulus to households with children eligible for **free or reduced-price school meals through National School Lunch Program (NSLP)** during the COVID-19 Response.

During the COVID-19 State of Emergency, Kentucky is providing benefits to households with students who attend public schools or private schools and qualify for free or reduced-price meals if the student's school district has a virtual or hybrid learning model.

P-EBT stimulus payments will begin the week of March 15, 2021. The stimulus payments are issued for past months covering October 2020-present and will continue through the rest of the school term (May 2021).

Am I eligible for the P-EBT Stimulus?

Does your student attend school in-person?

YES NO

Students on a full-time, in-person schedule ARE NOT eligible for the P-EBT stimulus.

Was the student's school district schedule only virtual, or a hybrid schedule (both virtual and in-person)?

VIRTUAL HYBRID

Students who receive free and reduced-price meals through NSLP receive \$136.40 (20 days) of P-EBT stimulus.

Students who receive free and reduced-price meals through NSLP receive \$81.84 (12 days) of P-EBT stimulus.

How will I receive my P-EBT Stimulus?

Households enrolled in SNAP and who have an active EBT card will be issued P-EBT stimulus payments on the existing EBT card.

Households that **do not** receive SNAP will be issued P-EBT stimulus on their existing card or if you're a first-time recipient a P-EBT card will be mailed to you. If you lost your card or need a replacement, contact 1-855-306-8959

If you feel you were incorrectly determined virtual or hybrid, call 1-855-306-8959 for reconsideration. Caller must be able to provide:

- Student's Full Name
- Date of Birth (DOB)
- 10-digit State Student ID (SSID)

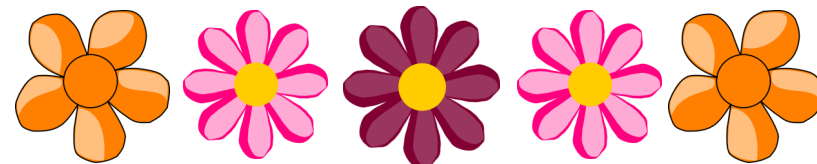

MEET THE BOARD Interview with Mr. Marshall Gray



Marshall Gray graduated from Western Kentucky University with degrees in Corporate Communications & Business Management. Marshall directs four business operations for Western Kentucky University. The Postal Services Department, which handles all incoming, internal and outgoing university business mail for WKU. The Printing Services Department, in which he oversees the operations 8 vendor contracts that produces all printed materials for WKU, the Vending Services Department, which operates WKU's exclusive beverage contract with Coca - Cola and Canteen and the WKU Passport Services which was recognized and presented an award by the US Department of State as an Outstanding Passport Acceptance Facility.

Marshall is the original owner of The UPS Store at Buckhead Square. He opened The UPS Store at Buckhead Square in 2005 and grew the business from the ground up. The UPS Store is one of two original businesses in Buckhead Square that has been in operation since the inception of Buckhead Square. He sold the business and has continued to play an active role in the Bowling Green community. Marshall has also been involved throughout the WKU & Bowling Green community over the years. His involvement over the years has ranged from Chair of the WKU Staff Senate, member of the WKU budget council, President for the Bowling Green/Warren County NAACP, member of the City of Bowling Green Police Chief Citizens Task Force, member of the Bowling Green Human Rights Commission, the National Board of Directors for the College & University Mail Services Association, President of the WKU Society of African American Alumni, member of the WKU National Alumni Board of Directors and currently the Vice-Chair of the Housing Authority of Bowling Green, Board of Commissioners.

Marshall was born in Hopkinsville KY, the son of Marshall and Betty Gray, the oldest of four children. Marshall knew from an early age in life that he wanted to own his own business and be a servant to his community.

Marshall is married to Sonya Gray and they have two daughters, Makayla and Mariah. Marshall is a founding member of Next Level Church and a member of Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity, Inc.
