- *If you plan to be away during cold weather, leave the heat on in your home, and set to a temperature no lower than 55° F

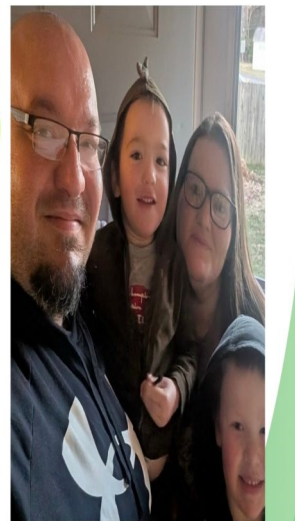
Katie Banks

KELLYE RICHARDS

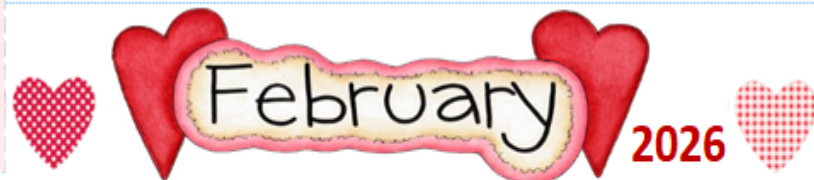
