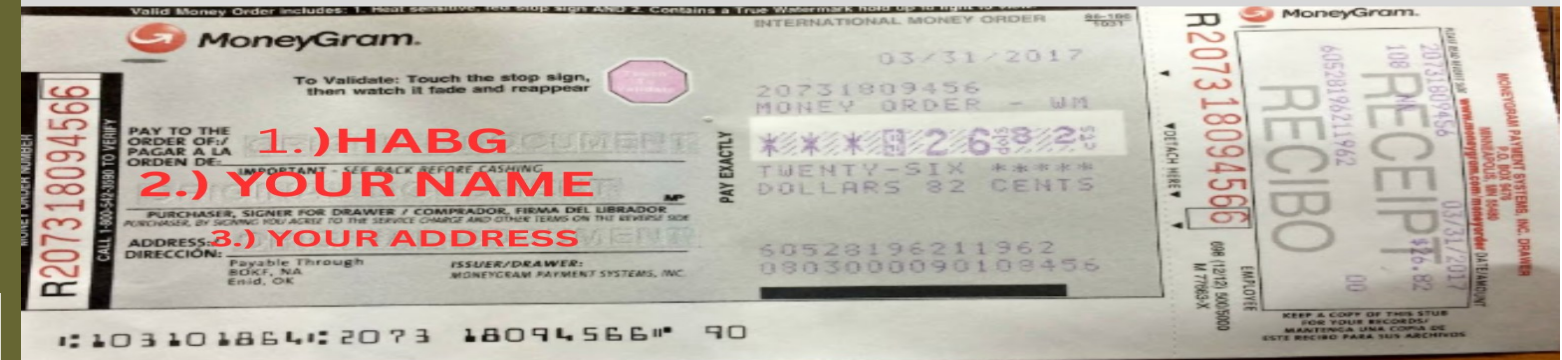

The Housing Authority of Bowling Green is committed to achieving excellence in providing safe, clean and modern housing assistance while promoting self-sufficient, upward mobility, and homeownership opportunities to its residents.

A few lease reminders...

- You are responsible for your guests. You are subject to eviction for criminal activity or drug related activity on property by guests.
- If you are resident you can be evicted for criminal activity, drug activity, or alcohol abuse on or off the premises.
- It is the tenants responsibility to keep their premises in a safe and sanitary manner. Not doing so is a lease violation and could lead to eviction.
- Utilities must be maintained in the tenants name - this includes BGMU and ATMOS. If these are disconnected it could lead to eviction.

The HUD Inspector will be here to inspect our developments between the dates of June 8th - June 18th.

The inspection has changed and is focused on the inside of the unit. Some of the new items on the inspection list are:

1. Clutter
2. Housekeeping
3. Empty cans, bottles, or food wrappers lying around the apartment
4. Dirty tubs
5. Anything flammable within three feet of a gas furnace. Flammable is any object, such as paper, cloth, wood, or plastic. (anything that can burn)
6. Evidence of roaches, mice, etc.
7. Checking smoke detectors and carbon monoxide alarms

It is important that if you have a work order that it is called into your maintenance office.

Not all apartments will be inspected; the inspector will randomly select a percentage of apartments from each development. You are not required to be present during the inspection. If you are not at home, the Housing Authority Staff will leave a note in your apartment advising you that the Housing Authority Staff and the HUD REAC/NSPIRE Inspector were there.

Housing Authority staff will always be with the inspector. Remember, keep your apartments and yards clean and in good condition.
