If you are in need of food please contact one of our service coordinators. Also there is are food pantries located in the Main Office as well as our Angora Court Office.

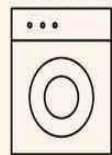

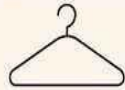

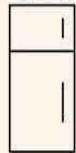

MONTHLY



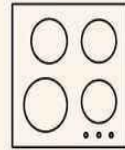
